FYI

- We have had two quotes on the heating conversion for the church. The first one we received from Bob Hecimovich Mechanical Contracting, Inc. was for \$73,600 and the other one from Iron Range Plumbing & Heating was for \$31,240. We are also looking into other options. The city of Virginia will give us a no interest fifteen year loan for the cost of the conversion.
- We paid half down (\$50,000) on the building in November. The balance will be due in November 2019. You can give toward this by designating money to the building fund.
- The building in Aurora has been listed with ReMax for \$119,900. Pray that the Lord will provide a buyer for this property.
- There is a signup in the foyer for cleaning the church in 2019. Four people are needed for each week.
- Jim & Anne Steel will be with us in February for a Bible Conference (8-10). We will also have a dedication service for our new building. We'll give more details as they become available.
