Love in Action

If the law of Christ (and therefore Christianity) is love then love must be important. To learn to love the way Christ loved is therefore the key understanding the Christian life. Ephesians 3:16-19 This is Paul's prayer for the Ephesians (note that after this he gives the promise of the power of God in their lives in vs. 20-21).

*Love is more important than obedience because love produces obedience John 14:15, 23-24, 15:10, 2John 1:6 And *this is love, that we walk after his commandments*. In this Jesus is our example as well: John 14:31. *Love is more important than knowledge for love is humble, rejoices in truth, and seeks to edify while knowledge can lead to selfish pride (1 Corinthians 13:4-8, 8:1).

*Love is more important than gifts and works 1 Corinthians 13:1-3, 8 for they are worthless without love.

*Love is greater than faith & hope for it will last forever. 1 Corinthians 13:13

Love is more than affection or sentiment, to be effective, love must be demonstrated. Jesus is our example: *By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren* (1 John 3:16).
