
Dear Parent,

A Massive Structure

Ark Encounter is the largest timber frame structure in the world, built from standing dead timber, in part by skilled Amish craftsmen. The Ark is an architectural and engineering wonder containing three decks of world-class exhibits.

When:

$May 6^{th} - May 9^{th}$

General Itinerary:

Thursday May 6: Leave early morning for 13 hour trip to Kentucky in passenger vans.
Friday May 7: Spend day at Creation Museum, return to house in the evening
Saturday May 8: Spend day at Ark Encounter, return to house in the evening
Sunday May 9: Leave in morning for trip home. Arrive home by 8:00 PM



The Creation Museum shows why God´s infallible Word, rather than man´s faulty assumptions, is the place to begin if we want to make sense of our world. At the heart of the Creation Museum is a chronological retelling of biblical history in seven parts called the Seven C´s. Guests step back in time, beginning with Creation, and fast-forward to Christ´s return. Along the way, they see how God´s Word provides the big-picture answers for our most difficult questions, whether about science, the Bible, or our personal relationship with God.

Travel, Food, and Lodging:

The current plan is to utilize passenger vans made available by church membership to travel to Kentucky. Vans would be driven by youth group directors and additional chaperones. Depending on the number of attendees, we expect to rent 1 or 2 houses designed for large capacities located near the Answers In Genesis attractions. Breakfast and dinners will be prepared and eaten at the rented homes. Lunches will be purchased at the attraction cafeterias.

Cost:

The cost to attend is \$240/person. This cost covers travel cost, admission fees/activities, lodging, and 3 meals/day. Youth groupers are encouraged to bring additional funds if they intend to buy snacks/souvenirs/etc.

Youth groupers have multiple opportunities to raise funds for the trip. These include:

- 1.) Assist in preparing a meal for the church body on Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning, March 27-28
- 2.) Assist in preparing a meal for the church body on Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning, April 24-25
- 3.) Prepare a 1500+ word paper with one of the following subjects. This includes doing one round of edits after Evan reads it.
 - a. What I have learned from studying "The Story of Hope" lessons
 - b. What I'd like to learn about or understand better from the trip to Kentucky
 - c. Real life account(s) of how I applied something I've learned at youth group/church/camp or directly from reading the Bible and what I might have done otherwise
 - d. How I would share the gospel with my friend

If a youth grouper is able to participate in meal preparations (item 1 and 2) and completes a paper, the cost to attend will be fully covered.

Deadline:

In order to plan accordingly, youth groupers must return the attached form by **Saturday, April 3rd** to Evan if they plan to attend. If there is an issue with this deadline, just discuss it with Evan (218-780-9100).
